A **Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL)** is required for students that want to join one of our Career College programs.

- Complete the program application form.
- Receive the conditional offer letter outlining next steps for that specific program.
- Pay the non-refundable application fee and attend the interview where applicable.
- Clear all conditions listed in the offer and pay 50% tuition for deposit.
- Receive Letter of Acceptance (LoA) and Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL).
- Apply for the Study Permit visa within 10 weeks of receiving the LoA and PAL. Students also need to apply for the Co-op visa at this time.
